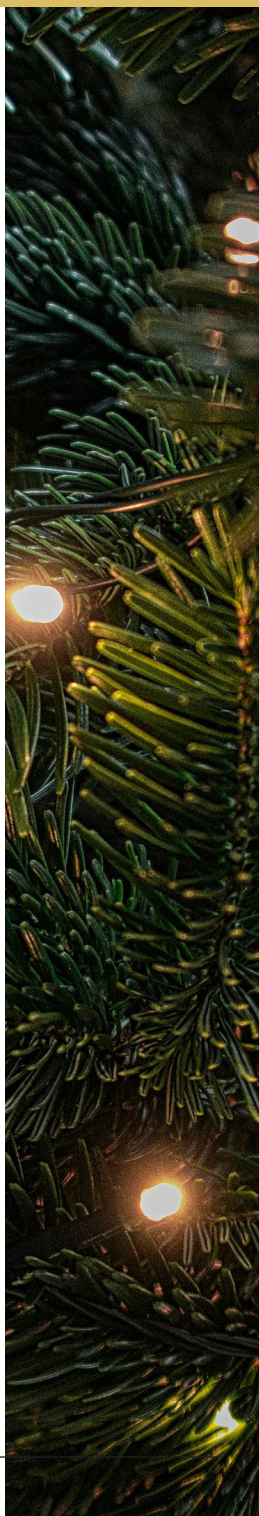

Paul Bryan leads a distinguished career as educator, performer, and administrator. He is a graduate of the Curtis Institute of Music and Temple University where he studied trombone with Glenn Dodson and Eric Carlson and conducting with David Hayes, Arthur Chodoroff, and Lawrence Wagner.

Active as both conductor and teacher, Paul currently serves as Director and Conductor of Bravo Brass—the PYO Music Institute brass ensemble, Director of Orchestral Activities at West Chester University and Music Director of the Symphony in C Summer Camp. Paul also serves as a faculty member at the Curtis Institute of Music and Temple University's Boyer College of Music and Dance.
